

UNIFORM DRESS CODE 2026

All students in **Year 7 to 12** are required to wear full school uniform every day, during official school events and excursions unless otherwise instructed. The cooperation of parents/guardians is expected in delivering a high standard of appearance for students. Parents having financial or other difficulties meeting these guidelines are asked to contact the school.

School Uniform (Summer or Winter)

- Students can elect to wear either full summer uniform or full winter uniform.
- White school shirt with school logo paired with the tailored grey school pants or HHS formal shorts.
- White school shirt or jacquard blouse with school logo paired with the HHS tailored grey school pants, tailored shorts or box pleat skirt with black tights.
- Alternatively, the summer dress can be worn but cannot be accompanied by tights, pants or leggings.
- All skirts and dresses must be of an appropriate length (mid-thigh or longer).
- School V-neck nylon windcheater, rugby jumper and/or soft-shell jacket can be worn as part of either the summer or winter uniform.
- The girls lined sports shorts and stretch microfibre shorts cannot be worn in combination with the white school shirt or jacquard blouse.

Sports Uniform

- It is compulsory for all students to wear the sports uniform on all days that they have Sport and Physical Education classes. They also need to wear this uniform when participating at interschool level.
- Grey micromesh sports polo can be worn with the Healesville High School zip-cuff black tracksuit pants, stretch microfibre shorts or girls lined sports shorts.
- The rugby jumper and/or soft-shell jacket can be worn with this uniform.
- Plain black or school bucket hats should be worn as part of this uniform when participating in outdoor classes.

Other items to be purchased

- All black school shoes. No white or alternate colours are acceptable on black school shoes.
- Appropriate running shoes must be worn with the sport uniform.
- White or black socks can be worn.
- A plain white long or short-sleeved t-shirt or skivvy may be worn under the school shirt or dress.
- Plain black scarves may be worn.

Clarifications

- Students may receive promotional polo tops as part of the production or music teams. These items can be worn as part of the school uniform during the term of the event they relate to.
- Non school jackets are NOT to be worn at school or to and from school.
- Hooded jumpers will never be permitted at school. Students will need to remove them.
- Only Healesville High School Beanies can be worn in the school grounds. No hats, beanies or headwear are permitted to be worn in classrooms.
- Hats are encouraged for use outdoors during Term 1 and 4. These should be school bucket hats or plain black.

During non-uniform activities:

- Clothes should be appropriate to wear to school (plain, neat and casual).
- Shoulders/stomach must be covered, sleeves and a collar are encouraged.
- Students cannot wear excessive jewelry or cosmetics.
- The following items cannot be <u>worn at school</u> at any time: Thongs, slippers, Ugg boots, unsafe shoes, inappropriate length shorts, skirts or dresses, items with offensive or inappropriate language/images or ripped/torn clothes.

Summary of action when students do not adhere to uniform or dress code:

- 1. In exceptional circumstances, when a student is unable to wear correct school uniform they are required to:
 - Wear items that are as close to school uniform as possible
 - **Bring a signed & dated note** to the General Office at the start of the day from their parent/guardian giving a valid reason.
- 2. Students out of uniform without a valid note will be given a pass, however, they will be given a lunch time detention.
- 3. Repeat offences will be followed up by the relevant Year Level Manager. Where appropriate, school support in sourcing uniform items will be provided and/or the student will be given additional consequences. Parents/guardians will be informed of repeated concerns.
- 4. If a students' clothing items are inappropriate for school (and they are unwilling to accept alternate uniform items provided), the student may be excluded from school activities.

Lost uniform items

All school clothing should be clearly labelled with the student's name. Lost items will be retained at the General Office.
